



Wallingford Regatta is not at Wallingford

The first regatta of the Summer Term is Wallingford on 30th April – but don't go to Wallingford to see the Radley crews. The regatta takes place on the Eton Rowing Course at Dorney (directions are on the next page). This is the venue for the 2006 World Rowing Championships at the end of August and for the 2012 Olympic Rowing and Canoeing.

You can park your car (£10 per vehicle) beside the course and watch the crews race on the six (and sometimes seven) lanes. Almost every Radley crew from Seniors to J14s will be racing.

Directions to the Eton Rowing Course at Dorney for Wallingford Regatta on Sunday 30 April



Exit the M4 motorway at Junction 7.

Go left onto the A4, direction Maidenhead, and over one set of traffic lights.

500 yards further on turn left at roundabout by Sainsbury's.

Follow road to Dorney village.

When road curves left, go right into Court Lane, signposted to Dorney Court and Dorney Lake

Go past Dorney Court.

At point where road curves right, go straight ahead into the Dorney Lake site through white gates.

Racing is over 1500 metres, starting at the main start and finishing at the 1500 metre mark – so the crews do not row the full 2000 metre course.
