### 1st VIII

The strong tailwind made rowing tricky, especially over the second half of the 2000 metre course where the boats were taking on plenty of water. Despite the absence of our usual stern pair who are both recovering from injury, the crew tried their best in the challenging conditions.

The 1st VIII qualified for the finals of the Junior Eights and Senior 3 Eights. In the Senior 3 Eights we really struggled and could only manage a distant 6th place overall in the final, but the crew had a more positive race in the Junior 1st Eights' division where they finished in 4th place, seven seconds behind the winners, Abingdon.

Although the training has been rather disruptive this term with two of the boys off sport, the "subs" have performed admirably. The crew know they have some catching up to do once the normal line-up is back together, but they are positive and enthusiastic about the challenge.

# Directions to Wallingford Regatta held on the Eton Rowing Course at Dorney Sunday 6 May



Exit the M4 motorway at Junction 7.

Go left onto the A4, direction Maidenhead, and over one set of traffic lights.

500 yards further on turn left at roundabout by Sainsbury's.

Follow road to Dorney village.

When road curves left, go right into Court Lane, signposted to Dorney Court and Dorney Lake  
Go past Dorney Court.

At point where road curves right, go straight ahead into the Dorney Lake site through white gates.

Racing is over 1500 metres, starting at the main start and finishing at the 1500 metre mark – so the crews do not row the full 2000 metre course.
