We entered two coxed fours in the fours event in the morning and the 'A' Four, despite only one practice session together as a crew, achieved a respectable third place in this division. The 'B' Four finished in 13th position in this division.

In the afternoon, most of the boys took part in the sculling head race and again they achieved some good results. George Stinton won a gold medal in the J17 event, finishing 9 seconds ahead of the second placed sculler and he was also a very respectable 5th overall. Henry Woodward-Fisher, James Lucas and Myles Watkiss finished 10th, 11th and 13th

respectively in the J18 division. Unfortunately Hugo Brine steered into the bank, losing a significant amount of time after looking set for a good result.

The event showed that our Michaelmas rowers are making steady progress. Next weekend four of the seniors will take part in the GB early identification sculling trials in Boston.
