
Willing to help. Radley Connect is different to other networks like LinkedIn, because everyone who joins has a shared affection for Radley College. This means we are able to create a highly engaged and supportive online community of those who are willing to help each other, both socially and professionally. From finding accommodation on a gap year trip to Singapore, to giving advice to someone who wants to change their career, Radley Connect is a forum for people to support each other.

What can you use Radley Connect for?

Finding and reconnecting with friends from Radley – Old Radleians, parents and staff are all invited to be members of the platform. You can use the directory to search by name or location.



Bringing our communities together overseas – the directory will help people to find each other/get together overseas as you can search by country and city to see who is close by.



Professional networking – the platform is designed for networking with others and has an advanced directory where you can refine your search by industry, company, position or country in order to make targeted and relevant approaches.

Finding out about 'real life' at universities

– you can search the directory by university and find out more about a university or a course directly from Old Radleians.

Sharing business connections - you can look up Old Radleians or Radley parents who are working in companies you are interested in, and seek advice.


Helping each other - for those starting out, or at a cross roads in their career, or if you just want some advice, you can use the directory to find individuals and see how they are willing to help



Messaging individuals for help – Radley currently has no formal mentoring programme in operation on this platform. We recommend users look at the 'Willing to help' profile of an individual before approaching them and start by sending them a message.

Finding work experience - from gap year placements, to work shadowing and internships, you can search the directory to find companies that Old Radleians are currently working in, and message them to find out more about that company.

Finding and posting jobs – simply go to the Jobs button and 'Post a job' giving it a clear end date.



Supporting entrepreneurism through sharing ideas & connections. Either connect with someone who you think would give you great advice, or post a general update on your

project.

Keeping up with news and events from the Radleian Society and the College on the Feed and in the Events button.
