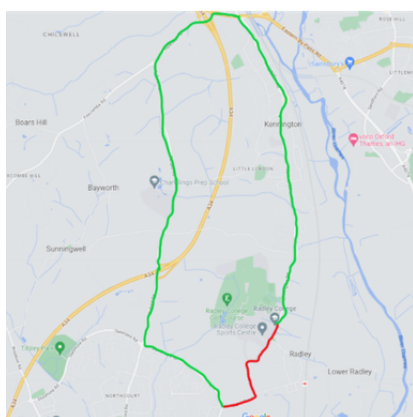

Any money raised will go towards a range of activities for young people to support their mental health, boost their self-confidence and inspire them to build social skills with their peers. The young people Oxfordshire Youth support have often come from very challenging backgrounds, some may have been taken into care, others may have arrived in the UK as unaccompanied asylum seekers. 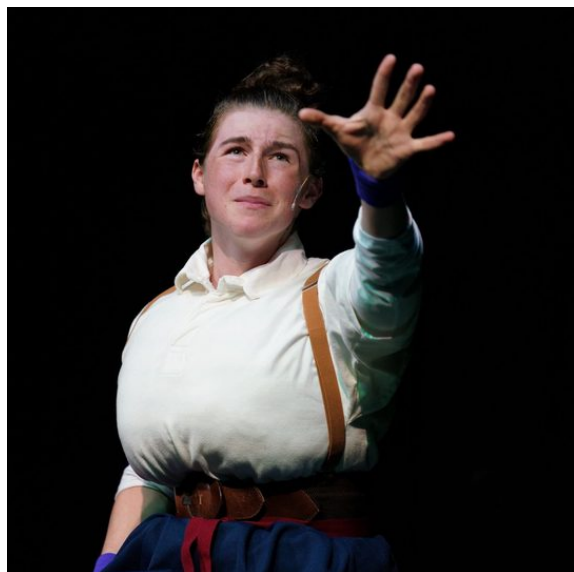
