



Radley College 2024 Scholarship Process

The 2024 scholarship process is now open and the link to the scholarship application form is available below and has been sent to all parents who have already expressed an interest.

This year we have launched a new award, the **Innovation Scholarship**. This exciting new prospect celebrates boys with a passion for design engineering, design electronics, coding, game design, robotics and technology. This award is offered alongside our Academic, Art, Drama, Music and Sport Scholarships. Further information about each, including deadline dates, can be found below and on our website [here](#).

2024 Sports Scholarship - deadline for entry 1st October 2023

Candidates need ideally to be outstanding in at least two of our major sports: rugby, hockey, cricket, tennis and rowing. A candidate may choose to enter three sports, but if he does so, he should be very strong in all three. If he is outstanding at two sports, this is enough to gain a Sports Scholarship. A Sport Exhibition can be gained if a candidate is truly exceptional in one of our major sports or in several other sports, including athletics, cross country, real tennis, racquets, squash and golf. Please note that candidates can select only one summer sport from: cricket, tennis or rowing. Finally, whilst we are happy to hear about candidate's football ability, it will not be assessed at scholarship.

2024 Innovation Scholarship – deadline for entry 1st October 2023

This new scholarship was created from the growth in interest in robotics, computer science, design engineering and entrepreneurship. We are looking for out-of-the-box thinkers with a genuine passion and aptitude for coding, game design, engineering, technology and problem-solving. They will have good technical ability, be dynamic, collaborative and an excellent communicator.



2024 Academic Scholarship – deadline for entry 12th November 2023

We are looking for high-achieving, academically talented boys to enter this scholarship which is conducted in two-stages. Shortlisted candidates post Stage One (English and Maths papers) will come to Radley to sit the Stage Two papers and they will also have two interviews.

2024 Art Scholarship - deadline for entry 12th November 2023

Candidates for this scholarship will be expected to show and discuss artwork in a range of media, and to present artwork carried out both at school and in their own time.

2024 Drama Scholarship - deadline for entry 12th November 2023

Candidates will be expected to prepare a monologue between 60 to 90 seconds chosen by the candidate (please do not perform a poem or declaim extracts from novels). In addition, candidates will take part in a workshop on the Assessment Day consisting of drama games, devising and sight reading.

2024 Music Scholarship - deadline for entry 12th November 2023

We are looking for candidates who have a genuine interest in, or passion for, music as well as demonstrating real musical achievement or exceptional promise. Associated Board Grade 6 is a guide to the minimum standard expected if only one instrument is offered. Lesser achievement in more areas of activity (including singing) may also lead to an Award, especially if there is clear potential for musical growth. Awards will be offered on the basis of their performance on the day.

Upon submission of an entry form and the application fee (for boys who have not already applied to Radley through the Radley List, Open Entry or Funded Places routes) we will acknowledge receipt and further information will be sent with details of the assessment day, after the appropriate deadline has been met.

For all scholarships, we very much encourage new, non-registered applications (Academic, Art, Drama, Innovation, Music or Sport); we have funds to support means-tested scholarships and we have reserved places for non-registered scholars. I hope you will get in touch if you have any candidates who may not have considered Radley to date. We are asking parents to complete an the online entry form for each discipline for which they wish to enter their son and on receipt of the form and the non-refundable entry fee of £350 (where applicable), we will request a Head's report from prep schools as well as relevant subject references.
