A letter from Jack's parents, Tania & Martin Chisholm

Our dear Jack, who brought such joy to so many of us, never returned from his latest adventure to a giant tortoise conservation farm in Florida. On arrival, he could not believe his luck that he would be spending four magical weeks in paradise looking after these majestic creatures, experiencing this eccentric paradise with wonderful company and even being paid for what was looking like possibly the best holiday of his life.

As we now know, the siren call of the shaded pool in the Florida midday heat was to become the place where he drew his last breath. As far as certainty can be possible, it seems he simply hit his head, was stunned and breathed in a lungful of water. The medical report indicates he would probably have had no awareness of what was happening to him, which provides some comfort amongst the terrible sense of loss and pain.

We thankfully didn't need assistance with funding as Jack was still well insured as part of our household travel policy and he wasn't engaging in risky activity or under the influence of any substances, either of which could have voided his cover. Our kids are still young and many of them will seek adventure and take risks but they are also very likely to save a few pounds on insurance cover if booking a holiday themselves.
