



Dear Parents,

This week we start our Community Partnership Programme. More than 150 boys across the Vths, 6.1, and 6.2 will work alongside local organisations and schools. Nearly 90 boys will be working in primary schools supporting reading, maths, enrichment activities and sport. Another 25 will work in secondary schools to support GCSE maths, languages and reading.

Boys are also involved in providing weekly music concerts in local residential homes, working in charity shops, grounds maintenance in Radley village and with social enterprise groups. All programmes operate for 20 weeks, with many extending into the Summer Term. Please ask your sons about their involvement - they will gain as much as they give.

Flu Clinic


