Commonwealth Education Trust (CET) Fundraising Impact

Thank you to those parents who supported the boys with their fundraising for the Commonwealth Education Trust earlier in the year. We are now in a position to communicate the impact of the money raised - a stunning £8,000! This sum has led to more than 1,850 teachers being trained using the Teach2030 smartphone programmes created by CET. Class sizes are so much larger in Africa and other Commonwealth nations so CET estimates that 420,000 pupils are now getting a better education. Over the lifetime of those 1,850 teachers, we predict the training will benefit more than 10 million pupils. 


