The U15 crew placed second, coming in three seconds behind Hampton in their final and holding off a fast-finishing King's Wimbledon. There were also promising performances from the 2nd VIII and the U15B crew both making the final on the A category event, beating other schools' A boats along the way.

Master in Charge of Rowing Sam Townsend said: "Wallingford is always an extremely useful event for some of our top crews, providing them with their last multi-lane 2000m regatta before National Schools. The 1st VIII raced well to take an encouraging win and the other boats all fared well in their categories, demonstrating they have the capacity to fight for A Finals and medals at National Schools."


# VEX Robotics World Championships
