



When to start to apply

Online Entry forms must be received by the end of the summer term of Year 5. We recommend that you attend an Open Day at Radley during or before Year 5. All enquiries should be through the Admissions Department.

Entry Requirement/Pre-tests

ISEB Common pre-test to be sat by the end of November, Year 6. An interview for shortlisted candidates and the submission of a Head's report by the entry deadline. Unconditional offers are made in the Lent Term of Year 6.

GCSE/A level requirements

We expect boys to take 10 GCSEs and 3 or 4 A levels.
