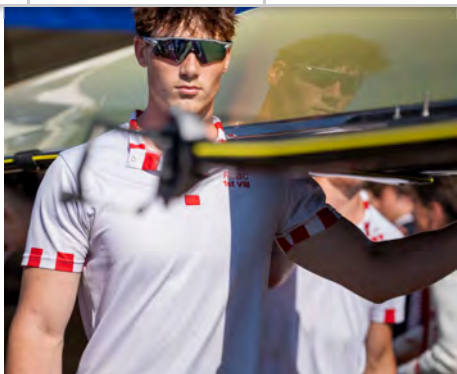

Henley Royal Regatta

Cricket Season

143 cricket matches saw 252 boys competitively representing the College, resulting in a 67% win rate – up from last year's 64% success. The boys also produced seven hauls of five or more wickets, and the first Bigside hat trick in a decade by Charlie (R, J) against Tonbridge. Will (V, J) has represented Gloucestershire in the 2nd XI while Manny (6.1, G) has represented Hampshire's 1st XI, the England U19 team at the World Cup and will be playing with Southern Brave in The Hundred.



Tennis Season

More than 200 Radley players joined Radley's Lawn Tennis Club, with 121 playing competitively. The season peaked with a fantastic performance in the Youll Shield at the ISTA Championships at Eton, making our U18 squad the sixth best school's tennis team nationally. Shells Cosmo (S, C) and Matthew (S, B) did brilliantly to reach the finals of the U15 Phillips Plate. George (6.2, J), has also been shortlisted to represent the Independent Schools v The All England Club. Pekko (S, F) has represented Finland and won the Iceland Open (U14) and Finland Doubles Open at U16.

Radley boys earned 29 Distinctions and 15 Merits in their Grade 8 LAMDA public

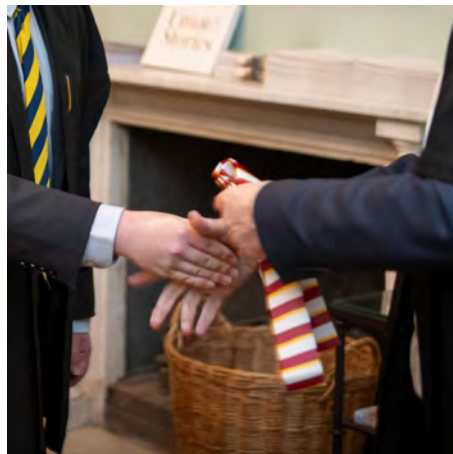

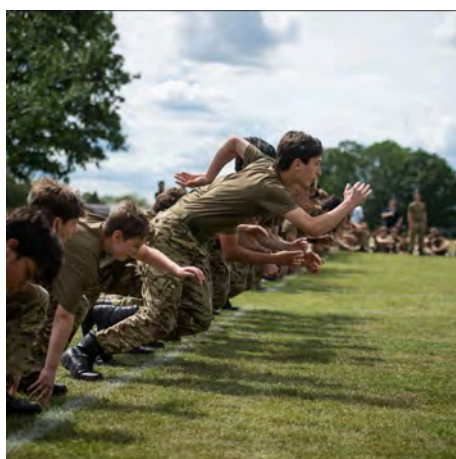
